



Figure 1: Structure of the Greek-owned SSS fleet



- SSS Greek –owned fleet includes all types of ships' categories (excl. fishing and maritime tourism vessels)
- Ships under 500 gt represent 1/3 of the total fleet (incl. passenger ships and ships providing port services)
- The core SSS fleet consists of ships between 500-20.000 gt following the increasing trend of ships' size.




Figure 2: Greek-owned SSS fleet (500-20,000 dwt)

• Tankers represent the major ship category of the Greek SSS fleet –almost ½ of the fleet. Comparing with the study of Nitsopoulos (2008)² it is concluded that the synthesis of the fleet does not present significant changes with tankers and bulker carriers being at the top.

² The study of Nitsopoulos (2008) includes SSS till 6.000 dwt

- The average age of the SSS fleet is estimated at 18.6 years portraying that the Greek fleet is aged. The 20+ category is the main age category (42.4%)
- Based on 2009 data 50% of the European Shortsea Fleet ³ is over 20 yrs old.
- Comparing Greek data with the corresponding European, almost the same age pattern is observed.
- The average size of the GR-owned fleet is estimated at 13.1 thousands dwt implying that there is a trend towards the increase of SSS ships' sizes.

Figure 3: Age structure of Bulk and General Cargo ships



The average age of the SSS bulk and cargo vessels is 21.3, however the age category of 20+ represents almost half of the fleet. 1/3 of the fleet is classified between 6-10 yrs old




Figure 4: Size structure of Bulk and General cargo vessels

- The average size of the SSS bulk and cargo vessels is 7.100 dwt
- The major size category is this of 5,001-10,000dwt (38%), followed by the 3,001-5,000 dwt category (23%). This is indication of the gradual increase of the SS Ships' size.




Figure 5: Main flags of SSS BC and GC fleet

- The top three registries are Greece (17.1%), Panama (17.1%) and Malta (15.4%).
- Cost is the major factor for the selection of registry
- Geographic activity also affects registry selection

Figure 6: Age structure of SSS Tanker fleet



- SSS tanker vessels –compared with the other ship categories- are less old.
- The major age category is this of 6-10 yrs (36.5%).
- However, 1/3 of the tanker fleet is over 20 yrs old.




Figure 7: Size structure of Tanker fleet

- The average size of the SSS tanker fleet is estimated 7,849 dwt.
- In terms of size, the majority of the SSS GR-owned tankers are over 5,000 dwt. Specifically, the 5,001-10,000 dwt category represents 29% of the fleet, while 1/5 is between 10,001-15,000 dwt.
- Significant size category is this of 3,001-5,000 dwt representing almost 25% of the Greek fleet.




Figure 8: Main flags of SSS Tanker fleet

- Top registry is this of Panama representing 22% of the flags recorded
- Marsall Islands (20.1%) and Greece (18.4%) are among the top three registries

Figure 9: Age structure of SSS Container fleet



- Containers represent a smaller percentage of the GR-owned SSS fleet.
- More than 50% of the present fleet is over 20 yrs old and only a limited percentage of 5% is till 5 yrs old.
- The average age of containers vessels is 20 yrs old.




Figure 10: Size structure of SSS Containerships Fleet

- The average size of the container fleet (in terms of dwt) is 11.212 dwt.
- Container vessels are, compared to the other categories, larger by at least 4,000 dwt.
- Container ships till 3,000 dwt represent only 1.6% of the total container fleet, while the size category of 3,001-5000 dwt is less than 5%.
- The major category is this of 10,001-15,000 dwt representing more than 40% of the fleet.




Figure 11: Main flags of SSS Containerships fleet

- Totally, 27 different registries are recorded
- Again the main registry is this of Panama representing almost 24%, followed by BS with 20.3%.
- It is noted that the vessels flying the Greek flag represent only 0.8% (1 ship)

Figure 12: Age structure of SSS Ro-Ro fleet



- The average age of the SSS Ro-Ro fleet is 31.3 yrs old. Compared to the other segments this is the most aged category
- It is noted that all ships are over 16 yrs old and no ship was classified in the 0-15 yrs category
- 84% of SSS Ro-Ro ships is over 20 yrs old.




Figure 13: Size structure of SSS Ro-Ro- Fleet

- The average size of the SSS Ro-Ro fleet is 3,800 dwt implying that this fleet category consist of smaller ships.
- 80% of the fleet is till 5,000 dwt while no ship is recorded in the 15,001-20,000 dwt category.




Figure 14: Main flags of SSS Ro-Ro fleet
